School Rules

1. Pupils are to attend punctually at 9:20 a.m.
2. Pupils may not leave the school premises until dismissal time - 2:00 p.m. in the case of infants & 3:00 p.m. in all other cases - except with written/telephone permission of their parents/guardians.
3. (a) If parents/guardians wish their children to leave the school premises during lunch break, i.e. 12:30 - 1:00 p.m., then the appropriate form - obtainable from the school, must be signed and returned to the school.
(b) In the case of Infants who travel on school transport and have no alternative means of travel (i.e. they cannot be collected at 2:00 p.m.) these children can be accommodated in school until 3:00 p.m. Parents/guardians must sign the appropriate form, obtainable from the school, and return said form to the school.
4. A pupil must always bring a note when for any reason he/she seeks permission to leave the school early and in no case will permission be granted without a note/telephone message.
5. Toys and games are not allowed in school.
6. Additional school rules and polices are on file and can be viewed by appointment in the school office.
7. Mobile phones, make-up & jewellery are not allowed in school.

Conduct

Pupils are expected to behave themselves at all times in such a way as to bring credit to themselves, their parents/guardians and their school.

1. In school pupils are expected to move around in single file; to **walk** not run; not to run around, shout, be rough in corridors, toilets or classrooms.
2. Pupils should use only entrances for their own classes.
3. Pupils should show respect their Teachers and other adults by being mannerly, polite and obedient.
4. Pupils show respect for their schoolmates by being kind and thoughtful, by not interrupting teachers or fellow pupils, and by doing their work quietly and neatly.
5. Respect Property-
 - (a) School Property: Pupils should not mark, damage or break anything in school.
 - (b) Other People's Property: Pupils should not steal. They should be honest at all times. Any articles found should be handed up.

Litter

1. Pupils should put litter into bins provided by school.
2. Bubble gum/chewing gum is forbidden.
